DEADLINE: to be eligible for the scholarship all applicants must register by 11.July.2017 on eastwest.eu/it/eastwest-forum-2017 and attend the Forum on 12 July between 8.30 am and 2.30 pm, at the Polo Tecnologico in San Giovanni a Teduccio (Naples).

1. Scholarship characteristics

The Eastwest magazine and the Europeye Publishing House will award students with European citizenship enrolled in any European University in the faculties of Engineering, Political Sciences, Communication Sciences, Law and Economics with a scholarship for the academic year 2017/2018.

- a) Purpose of the scholarship: the scholarship gives students the opportunity to undertake a Master's degree and follow Research Projects chosen by the student;
- b) Field of Study: the students must be enrolled in in any European University in the faculties of Engineering, Political Sciences, Communication Sciences, Law and Economics (either public or private);
- c) The object of the scholarship: A course, master degree or Research Project which may relate to any subject pertinent to the study course being taken in the Institution and/or University;
- d) Number of available scholarships: 1, worth 1,500 Euro.

2. Scholarship application requirements and application presentation

- a) European citizenship;
- b) The scholarship is reserved for students under the age of 26;
- c) The student must be regularly enrolled and in step with all exams and assessments at the Faculties of Engineering, Political Sciences, Communication Sciences, Law and Economics;
- d) Having registered to attend the Forum by 25 June 2017

3. How to apply

Taking your cue from the discussions that take place during the morning of the Eastwest Forum 2017, prepare a specific question for each of the 3 panels:

- 1- Access to internet as a human right
- 2- Algorithms and Democracy
- 3- New business and employment models.

The questions must be delivered in written form on the same day – 12 July 2017 – attaching:

- one's personal details;
- a copy of University enrolment.
- telephone and e-mail contact details ;
- a presentation letter in which the candidate explains how he/she intends to spend the scholarship.

4. Allocation of the Scholarship

The Scientific Committee of the Eastwest magazine chaired by editor-in-chief Giuseppe Scognamiglio, will assess the questions and select the winner taking into consideration the student's university curriculum.

The assessment criteria will be based on the originality and level of insight revealed by questions, and on the demonstrable level of attention paid to the panel discussions.

The result will be communicated directly to the winner and published on Eastwest.eu by 30 September 2017 (date to be confirmed).

The winner will subsequently have to provide proof of having followed the indications provided in the letter of presentation: or of enrolment in the iOS Develop Academy, or the Master course, or of the project by attaching appropriate documentation. A letter from the University that certifies enrolment. All this documentation must be sent to the e-mail address: ewforum@eastwest.eu

4. Scholarship payment

The Grant of 1,500,00 euro gross shall be transferred directly onto the winning student's bank account.

5. Scholarship reimbursement

The student will forfeit the right to enjoy the entire scholarship sum and will be required to return the sums received, in the following instances:

- a) If the letter of enrolment in the Academy is not received;
- b) If the Academy Assessment letter shows a lack of participation in the activities reported in the study project;
- c) If the student doesn't complete the study or research period, as indicated in the University acceptance letter.
