



DOMENICO MANZIONE

Italian Undersecretary of State

Domenico Manzione joined the judiciary in 1983. He held the office of Deputy Prosecutor in Monza and Lucca and worked at the District and General Prosecutor's Office in Florence.

He was appointed twice a member of the Florence Judicial Council; he was also a member of numerous committees, including the criminal Trial Observatory, the committee on Agencies' administrative liability, the committee on the reorganization of organized crime legislation.

Manzione participated as a national representative in the preparatory work for drawing up EU legislation and in the pre-accession training of Hungarian judges and judicial police.

In 2009 he was nominated Public Prosecutor of the city of Alba and in 2012 he was appointed in the Board of Directors of the School for the Judiciary.

He worked as a lecturer at the Scuola Sant'Anna, the University and the Scuola Legale in Pisa.

He is co-editor of the magazine "La legislazione Penale"; and has published numerous works on criminal, procedural and judicial matters, including monographs.
